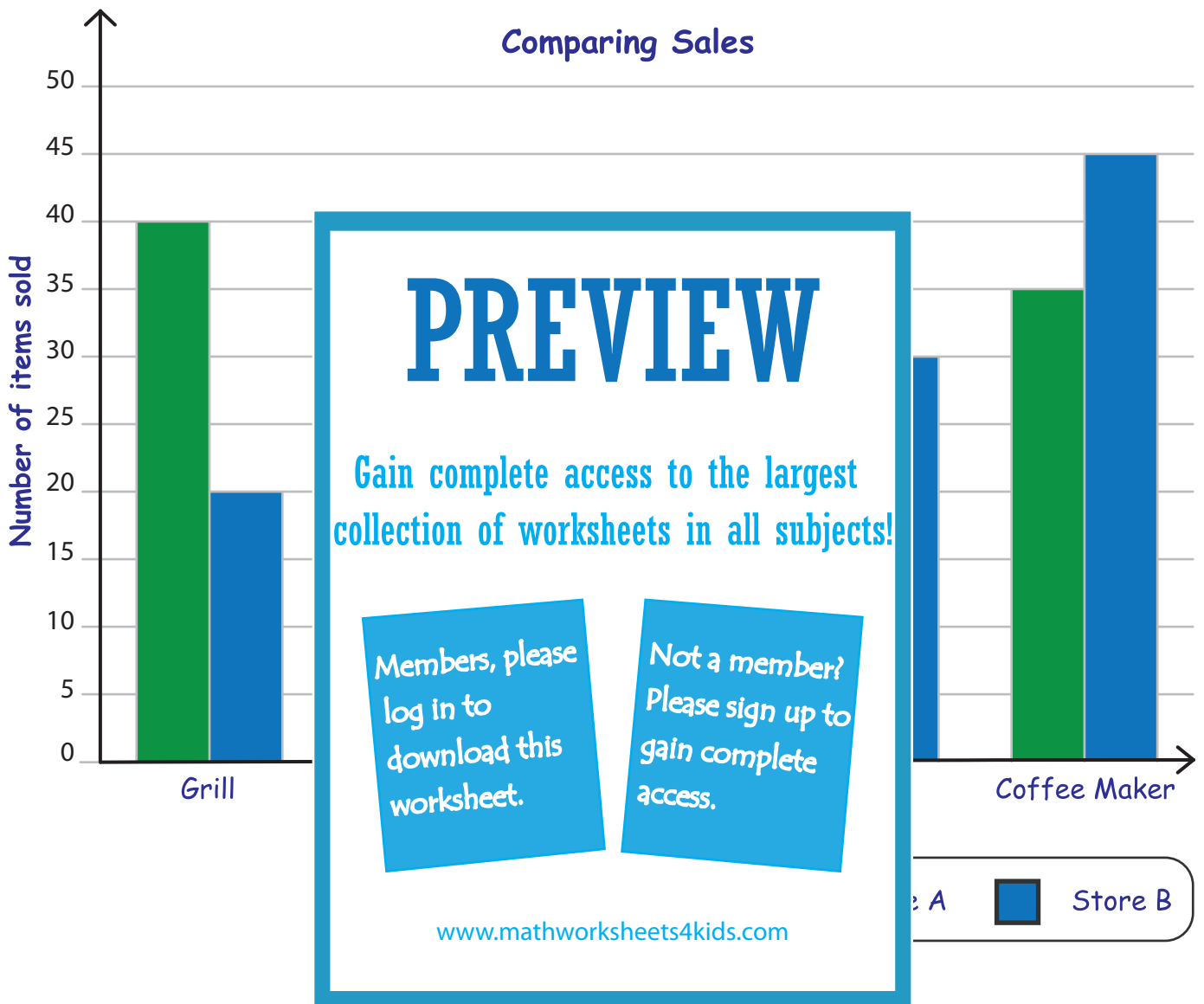


## Bar Graph - Comparing Sales

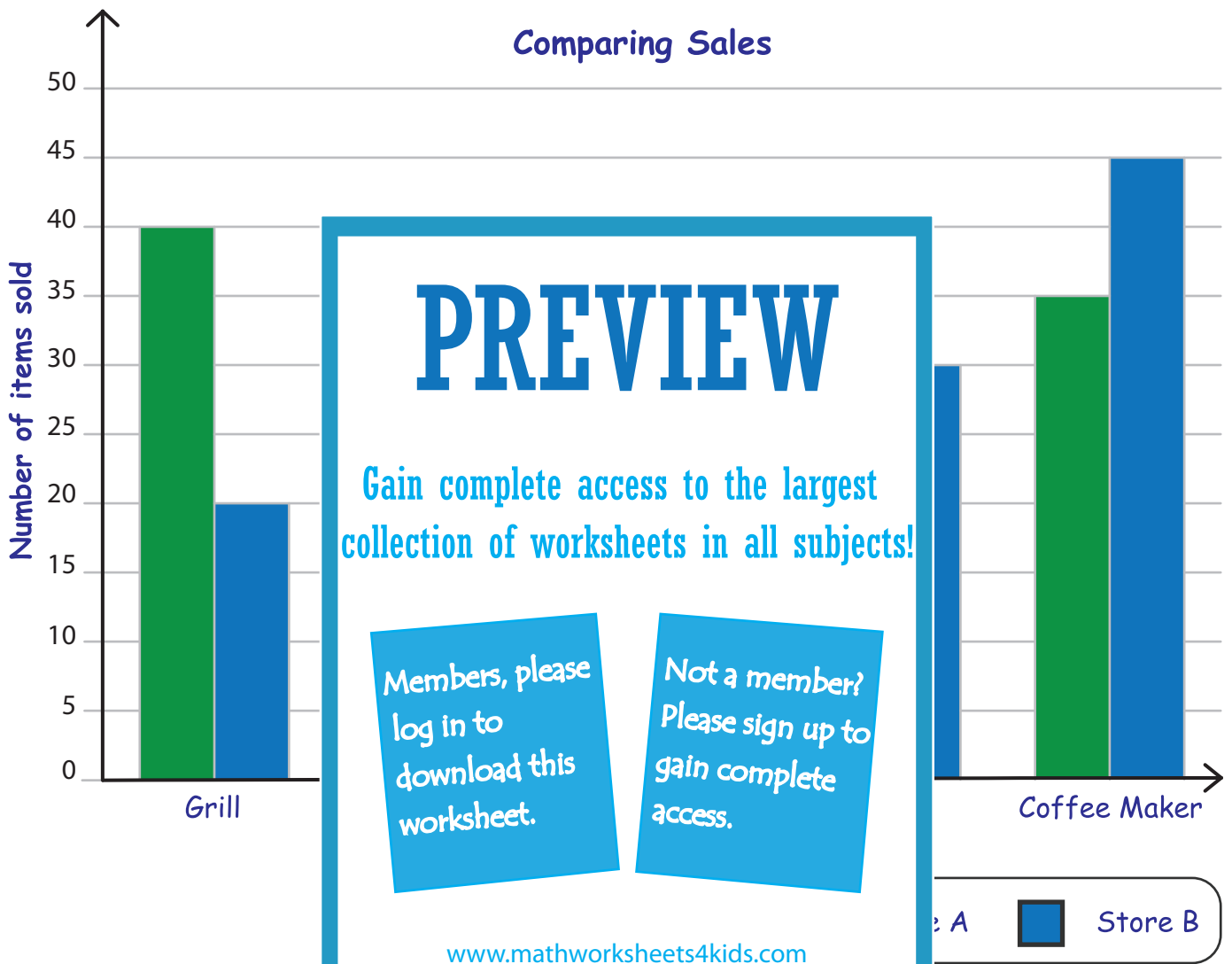
